PROFILE:

Professor Peter Boor received his medical and scientific training at the Medical Schools of Bratislava in Slovakia and Aachen Germany. Peter Boor is a senior consultant pathologist and the chair of Translational Nephropathology at the Institute of Pathology at the RWTH Aachen University. He is also the head of Electron Microscopy Facility and Digital Pathology and RWTH Lecturer. He is a member of several national and international societies of pathology, renal pathology and nephrology and he received several prestigious awards from these societies and prizes for excellent teaching of medical students. His group, the LaBooratory of Nephropathology, focuses on diagnostic biomarkers with particular focus on imaging, digital pathology and Al, as well as in vivo animal modeling, and understanding of pathological processes in CKD, fibrosis and vasculature. He founded and is leading the German National Autopsy Registry (NAREG) and Research Network (NATON). His scientific work encompasses more than 340 original papers, reviews and editorials, and several book chapters.
